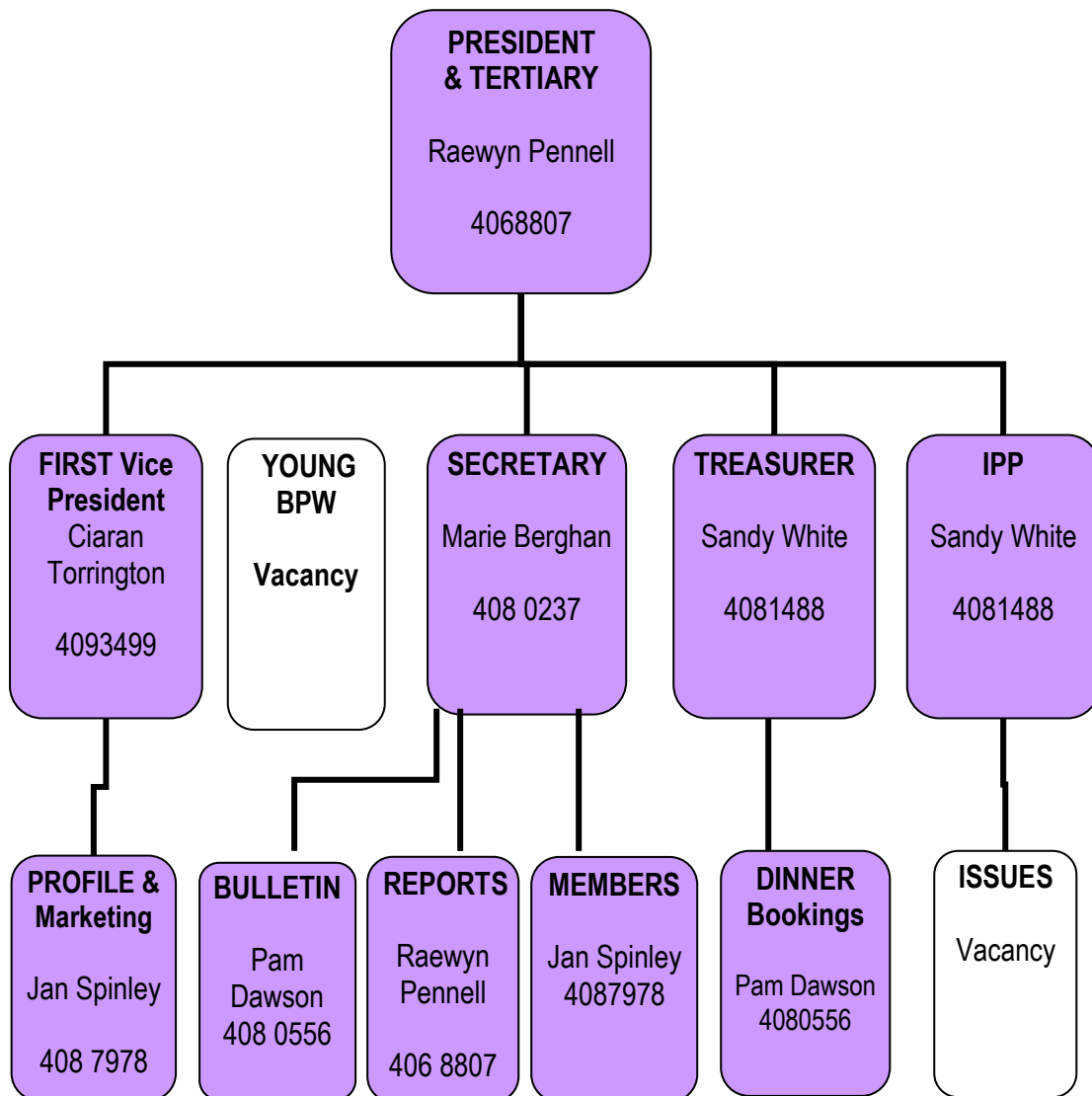
Keys to Achievement:
