This Call aims to identify and map proposals of activities and initiatives that can be held in the 8th World Water Forum event, if selected.

The Call for Proposals have two phases:

1. The **first phase** will review and analyze the submitted proposals considering the following criteria: coherence, practicability and relevance.
2. The **second phase** will be restricted for the selected proposals in the first phase and will consider financial and feasibility criteria.

The Citizens Process commission members after reviewing all proposals of the first phase will refer back, latest before the Second Stakeholders Consultation Meeting on April 2017.

Please consider that the activity proposed has to be interactive, involve more organizations and preferably different stakeholder groups and the public/ participants. The 8th World Water Forum motto is "Sharing Water", the themes are Sharing and Sustainability.

The main activity has to take place during the 8th World Water Forum. If there is a previous activity in a region or country before the Forum, there has to be a report mechanism during the Forum itself.

The proposals have to be submitted in English. Proposals for activities in the Americas or by (especially) South American CSO/ NGOs can be submitted in Portuguese, English or Spanish.
